

Anti-Bribery & Corruption Statement

Bribery and corruption are substantial threats to good governance, sustainable development, the democratic process and fair business practices. Bribery and corruption undermine attempts to achieve higher levels of economic and social welfare and impede efforts to reduce poverty. Corrupt actions also lead to loss of confidence in the public and private sector.

Guided by the OECD Convention on Combating Bribery and the UN Convention against Corruption, FMO maintains a zero tolerance policy regarding bribery and corruption. FMO is also a member of the Institutional Integrity Forum of Transparency International Nederland.

FMO's Management is committed to contribute to combating and preventing bribery and corruption in the public and private sector and has implemented an Anti-Bribery & Corruption (AB&C) Policy and Rules of Conduct (included in the Personnel Guide). FMO wants to ensure that its staff, clients and counterparties adhere to the highest ethical standards.

Third parties may report bribery and corruption practices related to FMO staff, clients or counterparties via the FMO Complaint procedure.
